



1 ~~[PROPOSED]~~ JUDGMENT RE: CONFIRMED ARBITRATION AWARD

2 IT IS NOW ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Corrected Final Award (the “Award”)
3 issued by a three-member panel of the American Arbitration Association on June 28, 2019, which
4 includes a monetary award to ATI Industries, Inc. (“ATI”) in the amount of \$3,272,005 to be paid
5 by Tara Materials, Inc. (“Tara”), is hereby confirmed in its entirety as the Judgment of this Court.
6 A true and correct copy of the confirmed Award, with redactions made to the Award is attached
7 hereto as **Exhibit 1**. The unredacted Award can be found in the Court’s sealed records attached to
8 Exhibit D in Tara’s Renewed Petition for Order Correcting or Vacating Arbitration Award filed on
9 July 8, 2019. This Judgment explicitly includes the redacted portions of the Award, which are only
10 redacted here because certain items referenced in the Award have been sealed by this Court.

11 Further, Tara must additionally pay ATI post-award pre-judgment interest on the Award’s
12 grant of \$3,272,005 to ATI. The amount of post-award pre-judgment interest due from the date of
13 issuance of the Award, June 28, 2019, until the date of entry of this Judgment, October 11, 2019, is
14 **\$94,126.20** (applying the applicable interest rate of 10% per annum, yielding a daily interest charge
15 of \$896.44, applied across 105 days).
